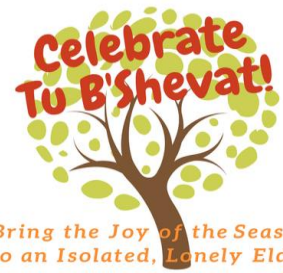




Share the Celebration of Tu B'Shevat with an Isolated Elder
